In response to rising environmental compliance costs and tough economic and power market conditions, the company reduced its budget and adjusted spending to meet the changing economics of the power generation industry. This impacted the number of jobs reported for creation at the time of the initial application. Part of the Illinois community since the 1960s, the Coffeen Plant pays \$3.2 million annually in property and other taxes and employs 207 people. Recent construction of scrubbers alone added approximately 15 new, permanent jobs and provided 1,000 temporary jobs -- many of these positions went to local residents. On April 18, 2011, AER Company's Coffeen Power Plant announced it had begun a major outage that involves replacing all 14, cyclones in the Unit 2 boiler and making several other plant improvements. This project has a positive impact on the economies of central and southern Illinois with approximately 400 contract workers being employed throughout the project.
